Dear Parishioners,

**Happy Pentecost!** This magnificent feast is the day that we recall how the Holy Spirit descended upon our Lady and the apostles 50 days after Jesus' resurrection, giving birth to our one, holy, catholic and apostolic church. Pentecost is the day that we pay special honor to the Third Person of the Most Blessed Trinity for all that He does to sanctify, console, guide, and strengthen us as we live out our earthly lives. Pentecost is also the day on which we reflect upon the role of the Holy Spirit in salvation history, and how He carried out the will of the Father so that we might be saved.

You'll notice that on Pentecost the priest and deacon wear the color red to symbolize the fire of the Holy Spirit that descended as tongues of flames upon Mary and the apostles. This red is meant to encourage us to be on fire with love for our Lord and His Church, founded by Christ upon the rock of Peter and brought to birth by the descent of the Holy Spirit. Just as the original Pentecost set the apostles on fire with zeal to go about preaching the Gospel to the ends of the earth, so too must we pray for a strengthening of the gifts of the Holy Spirit within ourselves to that we might be Christ's witnesses in the world.

One of the ways that we grow in virtue and are strengthened to live out our Christian faith is by regularly attending **adoration** of the Most Blessed Sacrament. As Catholics we are blessed to have our Lord so readily present to us in the Eucharist. Not only do we get to receive our Lord in Holy Communion, but we can also pray in His presence. Here at St. Ann's we have Eucharistic Adoration in our chapel every week from 8 a.m. on Tuesday until 5 p.m. on Wednesday. This is tremendous blessing and a source of grace for our parish, but it takes a lot of committed people to keep it going. As I've mentioned at Mass the past few Sundays, we are in need of folks to sign up for some of the morning hours, and we also need some more substitute adorers for when people go away or are unable to come to their normally scheduled hour. If you can help, please give us a call in the office!

In addition to our weekly adoration, we are in the midst of planning our annual **40 Hours** celebration, which will take place June 4 – 6. Our 40 Hours will begin with a Latin Mass at 7 p.m. on Thursday, 04 June 2015, with adoration to begin immediately following and continuing until 11 a.m. on Saturday, 06 June 2015. If you'd like to take an hour to adore our Lord, there is a sign up board in the church narthex. As always, we will have a Eucharistic procession around the parish property on Sunday, 07 June 2015, after the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Please join us! I especially invite all of our first communicants to take part in this beautiful custom by coming dressed in your suits and dresses.





These rooms exist to help you train your children how to attend Mass properly; thus, they should not be used as play rooms. While everyone who uses the cry rooms expects them to be a bit noisier than the church, disruptive games or toys are better left at home. Moreover, conversations in the cry rooms should be kept to a minimum during Mass. *Thank you for your consideration.*
