Dear Parishioners,

I hope that many of you are now making your way through *33 Days to Morning Glory*. As I mentioned in the homily last Sunday, Mary is absolutely indispensable to living our Catholic faith well. As the Mother of our Redeemer, the Spouse of the Holy Spirit, and the perfect model of holiness, Our Lady greatly aids us in our quest for holiness, comforts us in our trials and sufferings, and points out for us the narrow but sure path to Heaven. So as your pastor, I cannot encourage you enough to be devoted to her, to consecrate yourselves to her, to entrust yourselves completely to her maternal care!

As I also mentioned last Sunday, I've decided to push back the date for the mural's installation. While the artists feel they could be done in time to install the mural for our 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations on August 15<sup>th</sup>, I do not want to rush them. We've got a lot of time and money invested into this mural, and I'd rather it be absolutely perfect rather than have it installed by a certain date. There are some updated pictures of the mural on the website, so be sure to check them out! Although we do not have a date set yet for the mural's dedication, it will most likely be in early October.

Although we will not be dedicating the mural on August 15<sup>th</sup>, we are still going to celebrate the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our parish's founding. We will have a solemn high Latin Mass in the presence of Bishop Jugis at noon on that day, followed by a reception from 2-4 p.m. And we will also have special prayers to commemorate our anniversary at the 4:30 p.m. Mass that day. So regardless of whether you prefer to celebrate by going to the Latin Mass or to the regular Mass in English at 4:30 p.m., please join us for the reception that will occur between the 2 Masses! Just keep in mind that while the 4:30 Mass on August 15<sup>th</sup> will fulfill your Sunday obligation, the noon Mass will not. Moreover, because August 15<sup>th</sup> is a Saturday this year, it is not a holy day of obligation.

### **To All Parents with Infants & Small Children**

One of the most beautiful blessings of our Parish is that we have so many babies & small kids! While all children are most welcome in the church, please keep in mind that the acoustics in our church are excellent, which means that their voices carry. If your children cry or scream during the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, please be sensitive to those around you by taking your child to one of our cry rooms. *The cry rooms are reserved for families with small children. Everyone else is requested to sit in the church.*

### **To those in the Cry Rooms for Mass**

Please remember that these rooms are an extension of the church itself. Therefore, please be as reverent as possible during Mass. These rooms exist to help you train your children how to attend Mass properly; thus, they should not be used as play rooms. While everyone who uses the cry rooms expects them to be a bit noisier than the church, disruptive games or toys are better left at home. Moreover, conversations in the cry rooms should be kept to a minimum during Mass. *Thank you for your consideration.*

“We are pleased to announce that we now have outdoor speakers for those whose small children are too loud for even the cry rooms or narthex. Please be considerate of your fellow parishioners if your children are making a lot of noise.”

As you come into the church, please keep in mind that we have several parishioners & visitors with walkers & canes that would like to sit in the back by the baptismal font so the walk from their cars is not too far! Make sure to lock your cars & trucks. Either keep your personal items with you in church or lock them in your trunk. *This is for your safety.*
