Dear Parishioners,

This is a very special weekend for us at St. Ann's as our fellow parishioner, **Michael Carlson**, is ordained to the priesthood! Fr. Carlson is offering our regularly-scheduled 10:30 a.m. Mass this weekend as his first Mass. Please keep in mind that a plenary indulgence is available (under the usual conditions) to all who attend a priest's first Mass. And as I mentioned in last Sunday's bulletin, Fr. Carlson's ordination is a great blessing to our whole parish as there are wonderful graces given to families who produce vocations (both biological and spiritual families). Please keep Fr. Carlson in your prayers as he begins his priesthood!

As we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi this weekend, please keep in mind that we are in need of more adorers for **Eucharistic Adoration**. Since January 2012 our parish has been hosting Eucharistic Adoration 33 hours/week, from Tuesday mornings at 8 a.m., until Wednesday afternoons at 5 p.m. These hours are a chance for us to take a break from our busy schedules so that we might spend a quiet hour with our Lord and Savior. Yet we need people to be available to pray at each of these 33 hours in order to keep it going. I understand this is a commitment, but it's a commitment that reaps very beautiful spiritual fruit for those who undertake it – most especially a more intimate connection with our Lord. If you are not already one of our regular adorers, please consider signing up. I especially encourage those of you who are in any way struggling in life, have a particularly difficult cross to carry, who regularly feel anxious or alone, or who are discerning a vocation to become a regular adorer. Christ's peace, consolation, and wisdom are waiting for you in Adoration!

Lastly, for those of you who are interested, I'm leading a **pilgrimage to the Holy Land** March 8-19, 2020. Highlights will include Mt. Carmel, all the major sites around Galilee, Bethlehem, and Jerusalem, a visit to the Dead Sea, and a brief foray into Jordan to see Petra and Amman. Brochures are available on our website or at the back of our church. The cost is \$4088/per person for double occupancy. I hope you can join us!



**Latin Mass Q&A:** What do the Classes in the above calendar mean? The Class is the level of importance or solemnity (1st-4th) associated with that day's Saint or commemoration. A 1st Class Feast Day are many Sundays and major solemnities like Christmas. Feria is a non-feast day and readings typically revert to the prior Sunday readings.


