

Dear Parishioners,

Today is *Gaudete Sunday*! Much like *Laetare Sunday* in Lent, *Gaudete Sunday* signals that we are drawing near to our Advent goal of Christmas! In recognition that the great feast of Christmas in drawing nigh, *Gaudete Sunday* has traditionally been set aside as a day of rejoicing and a lightening of penance. It's for this reason that the color rose, instead of the penitential violet, is generally worn in the liturgy on this day.

To be well prepared for our Lord's coming, please consider going to confession before Christmas if you haven't already done so. We have confession every Thursday from 5:30-6:30 p.m. and every Saturday from 3-4 p.m. Many parishes offer confessions on other days during the week as well.

Looking ahead to next Sunday, please understand that, even though Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday this year, you must still attend <u>two Masses</u> next weekend: one for your obligation for the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time, and one to fulfill your obligation for Christmas. This may mean going to Mass twice on the same day!

Our Sunday Mass schedule and our Christmas Mass schedule will follow our normal patterns. This means that you'll need to go to one Mass in each of the groupings below:



St. Ann renewed our parish membership for **Open Light Media** on October 6th. The materials are produced by the **Dominican Sisters** so the content is excellent!



The Latin Mass has a different liturgical calendar and readings than the Novus Ordo (English) Mass. Any Mass schedule changes will be listed on Page 2 of the bulletin.

Latin Mass Q&A: What do the Classes in the above calendar mean? The Class is the level of importance or solemnity (1st-4th) associated with that day's Saint or commemoration. A 1st Class Feast Day are many Sundays and major solemnities like Christmas. Feria is a non-feast day and readings typically revert to the prior Sunday readings.


