

Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate of the Birth of Christ here at St. Ann's, I want to thank each of you for the many ways you share your gifts of time, talent, and treasure with our parish family. Your participation in the many good works of our parish community demonstrates that the light and love of the Christ Child shines brightly here at St. Ann's! I am particularly grateful to our dedicated staff and all of our volunteers who give generously of their time and talent to make St. Ann's the beautiful and big-hearted parish that it is.

Recognizing that this is the season of gift-giving, I ask you to prayerfully consider putting our parish on your year-end Christmas giving list. As we strive to meet the spiritual and pastoral needs of our parish family, we must also recognize the practical and financial needs of maintaining our parish on a day-to-day basis. Our weekly collections are not quite meeting our budgetary needs, and we are

struggling to meet our assessments for the DSA and the Priests' Retirement Collection this year. As you know, any shortfall on these assessments must be taken out of our parish coffers, limiting our ability to meet other parish needs.

In the past several years, we've been able to take care of several pressing maintenance needs in the church and the Allen Center, including a massive renovation of the Allen Center and the addition of the Marian Grotto. But, there is still much more to do! For example, you may have noticed the terrible condition of our parking lot, which is something we are hoping to remedy next summer (which will cost ~\$200,000). If you'd like to donate to this project, you can do by contributing to the 5-Year plan (either by envelope or on our website).

The good news is that we should retire the debt on the Allen Center project by May! This will leave us only with the debt we have on the rectory, which we hope to pay off in Spring 2027. Thank you for your generosity to our parish's capital needs.

Lastly, please keep in mind that Catholics are obliged to attend two Masses this weekend: one for your obligation for the 4th Sunday of Ordinary Time, and one to fulfill your obligation for Christmas. We will have Christmas Masses today (December 24) at 4:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m., and on December 25 at Midnight (Latin) and 9 a.m. Masses for the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God (January 1) will be 9 a.m. (Latin) and 12 noon (English). Masses next Sunday, December 31, will be as normally-scheduled.



St. Ann renewed our parish membership for Open Light Media on October 6th. The materials are produced by PENLIGHT the Dominican Sisters so the content is excellent! You




will find virtue training and fun videos for the family. *Manners Monday* is a favorite series. The kids love them! To access our new subscription, please follow the steps listed.

St. Ann's offers the Latin Mass on Sundays at 12:30 p.m., Wednesdays at 6:00 p.m., Fridays 7:00 a.m., and on select feast days. The Latin Mass has a different liturgical calendar and readings than the Novus Ordo (English) Mass. Any Mass schedule changes will be listed on Page 2 of the bulletin.

Latin Mass Q&A: What do the Classes in the above calendar mean? The Class is the level of importance or solemnity (1st-4th) associated with that day's Saint or commemoration. A 1st Class Feast Day are many Sundays and major solemnities like Christmas. Feria is a non-feast day and readings typically revert to the prior Sunday readings.
