Dear Parishioners,

As was announced at Mass last Sunday, our parish has been given an extraordinary opportunity. On Thursday, 15 February 2024, we will be hosting the arm relic of St. Jude the Apostle! In recent years the Holy See has been promoting the veneration of the saints by sending major relics of the saints on tour. For example, many of you will remember the visit of the major relics of St. Maria Goretti, Padre Pio, and the heart of St. John Vianney coming to our city in recent years. The visit of the arm of St. Jude is another one of these relic tours. While we were not on the original schedule, there was a cancellation by another parish, and subsequently I was asked if our St. Ann's would be willing to be a host parish.

The relic of St. Jude will arrive on the morning of 15 February, but as it will take 3 hours to set up everything, veneration will not begin until 1pm. Please do not come early asking to see the relic, as that will not be possible. Veneration will continue throughout the day until 10pm. We will have confessions as usual that evening (5:30-6:30pm), and there will be a special Mass in honor of St. Jude at 7pm. Please attend if you are able, as a plenary indulgence will be available that day (which requires that one receives Holy Communion).

As regards practical matters, keep in mind that there are likely to be big crowds here that day, as our parish is the only visit of this relic in our diocese. Moreover, lots of people will be trying to fulfill the requirements of the plenary indulgence (venerating the relic, receiving Holy Communion, confession within 20 days before or after the event, prayers for the Holy Father, and detachment from all sin). While we will have confessions that day, it's likely that the lines could be long, and I do not know yet if we will have confessors other than Fr. Jones and myself. As confession is widely available in our city, give some thought to making your confession on another day. Moreover, be aware that you will not be able to pray for very long directly in front of the relic, so be prepared to pray while you're waiting in line to see the relic. Lastly, I will trust that all of you will be helpful hosts to those visiting from our parishes.

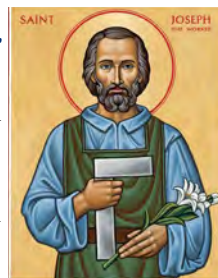
